nephews, Aaron and Angel, and niece, Bella, and his youngest half-brother Kyle, along with numerous family members on his maternal and paternal sides.

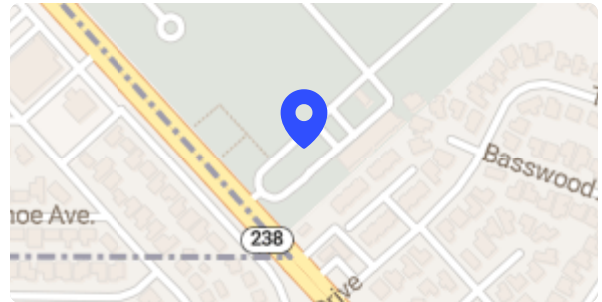

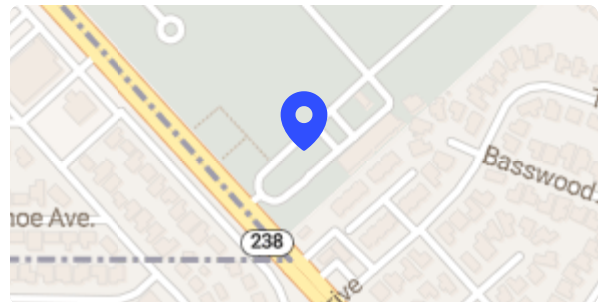
