Manny's final resting place will be in Eternity Memorial Park Cemetery, Bacoor, Cavite, Philippines

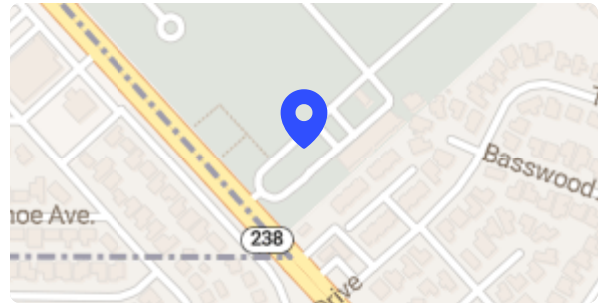
