With deepest sorrow, we announce that Alex M. Zonio passed away on September 14th, 2019. Although he was only 30 years old, Alex deeply affected many people in his lifetime and was respected and loved by all who knew him. He was born in Hayward, California in 1988 and graduated from Newark Memorial High School in 2007. Alex loved being a part of the Royal Rangers program and hunting with his father throughout his childhood. When he was in high school, he was dedicated to his wrestling, football, and track and field teams. He shared his love of wrestling as a coach for junior high school students. Alex enlisted for the Army National Guard when he was 17 and served for 13 years in the US Army. He was on active duty during the Iraq War. Alex is survived by his parents, Alex A. and Ping Zonio, his partner, Kim Hernando, and his beloved dog, Spike.
